**Population:** 34,612,250 (July 2011 est.)  
**Economy:** Uganda has substantial natural resources, including fertile soils, regular rainfall, small deposits of copper, gold and other minerals, and recently discovered oil. Agriculture is the most important sector of the economy employing over 80% of the workforce. Coffee accounts for the bulk of export revenues. Oil revenues and taxes will become a larger source of government funding as oil comes on line in the next few years

**Population:** 13,881,336 (July 2011 est.)  
**Economy:** Zambia's economy has experienced strong growth in recent years, with real GDP growth in 2005-10 of about 6% per year. Privatization of government-owned copper mines in the 1990s relieved the government from covering mammoth losses generated by the industry and greatly increased copper mining output and profitability to spur economic growth. Copper output has increased steadily since 2004, due to higher copper prices and foreign investment. Poverty remains a significant problem in Zambia, despite a stronger economy. Zambia's dependency on copper makes it vulnerable to depressed commodity prices, but record high copper prices and a bumper maize crop in 2010 helped Zambia rebound quickly from the world economic slowdown that began in 2008.
